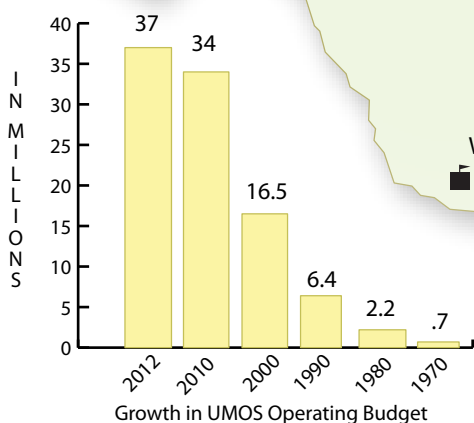
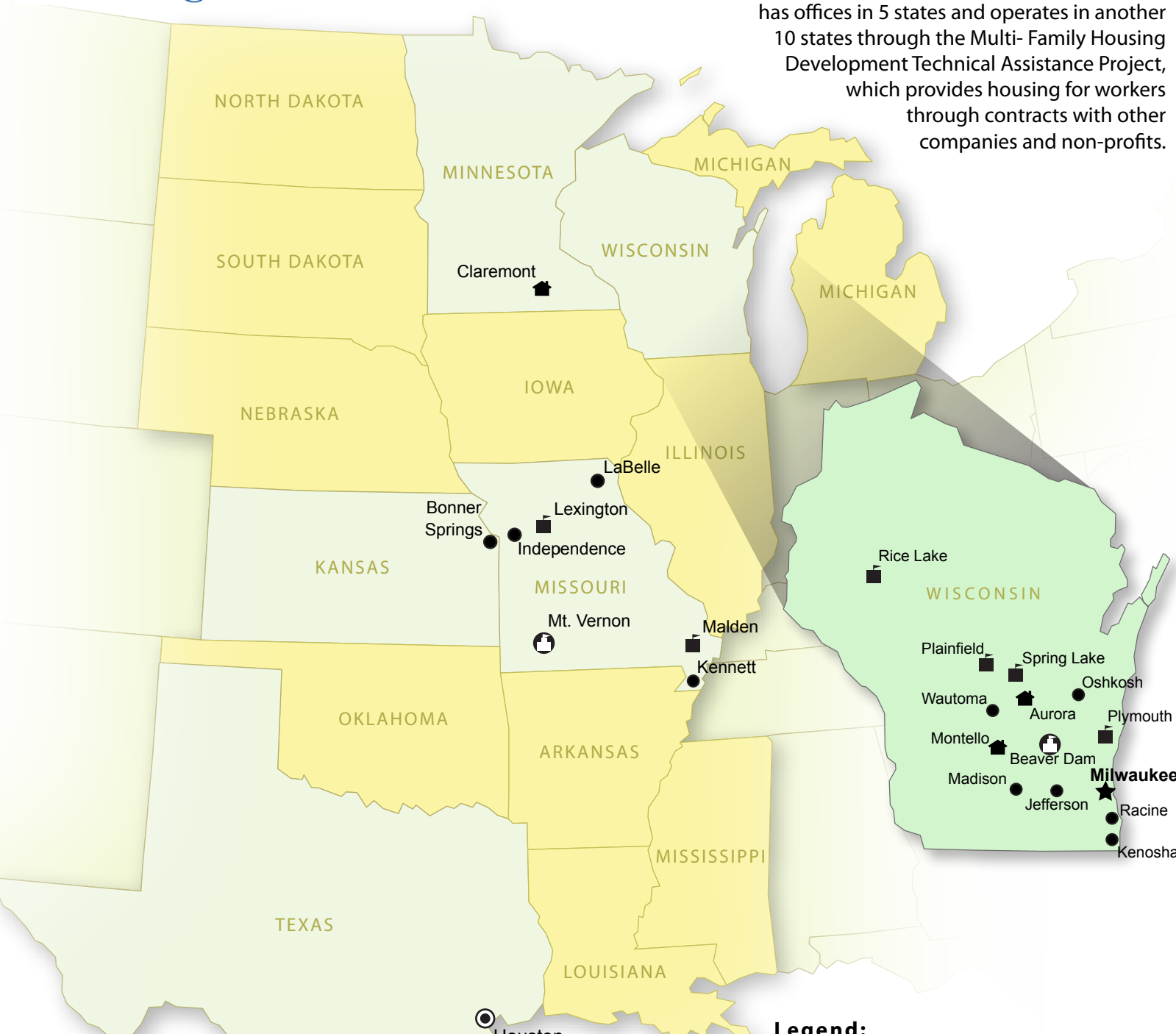


United Migrant Opportunity Services, a nonprofit advocacy organization, chartered in 1965, provides programs and services which improve the employment, educational, health and housing opportunities for migrant seasonal farm workers. UMOs provides these services for farm workers in 15 states. UMOs has offices in 5 states and operates in another 10 states through the Multi-Family Housing Development Technical Assistance Project, which provides housing for workers through contracts with other companies and non-profits.



Growth of UMOs:
 UMOs was founded by a consortium of diverse religious organizations on the south side of Milwaukee. Originally operated by a small group of volunteers, UMOs has grown into a multi-million dollar nationally recognized leader in the farm worker movement. UMOs also operates an employment center at its headquarters in Milwaukee which provides services including employment and training for over 30,000 individuals annually.
