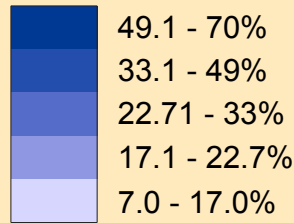

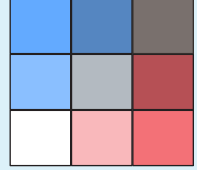

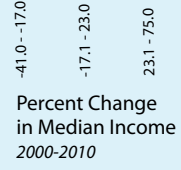

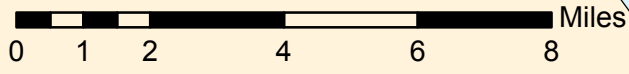
Median Rent 2010
