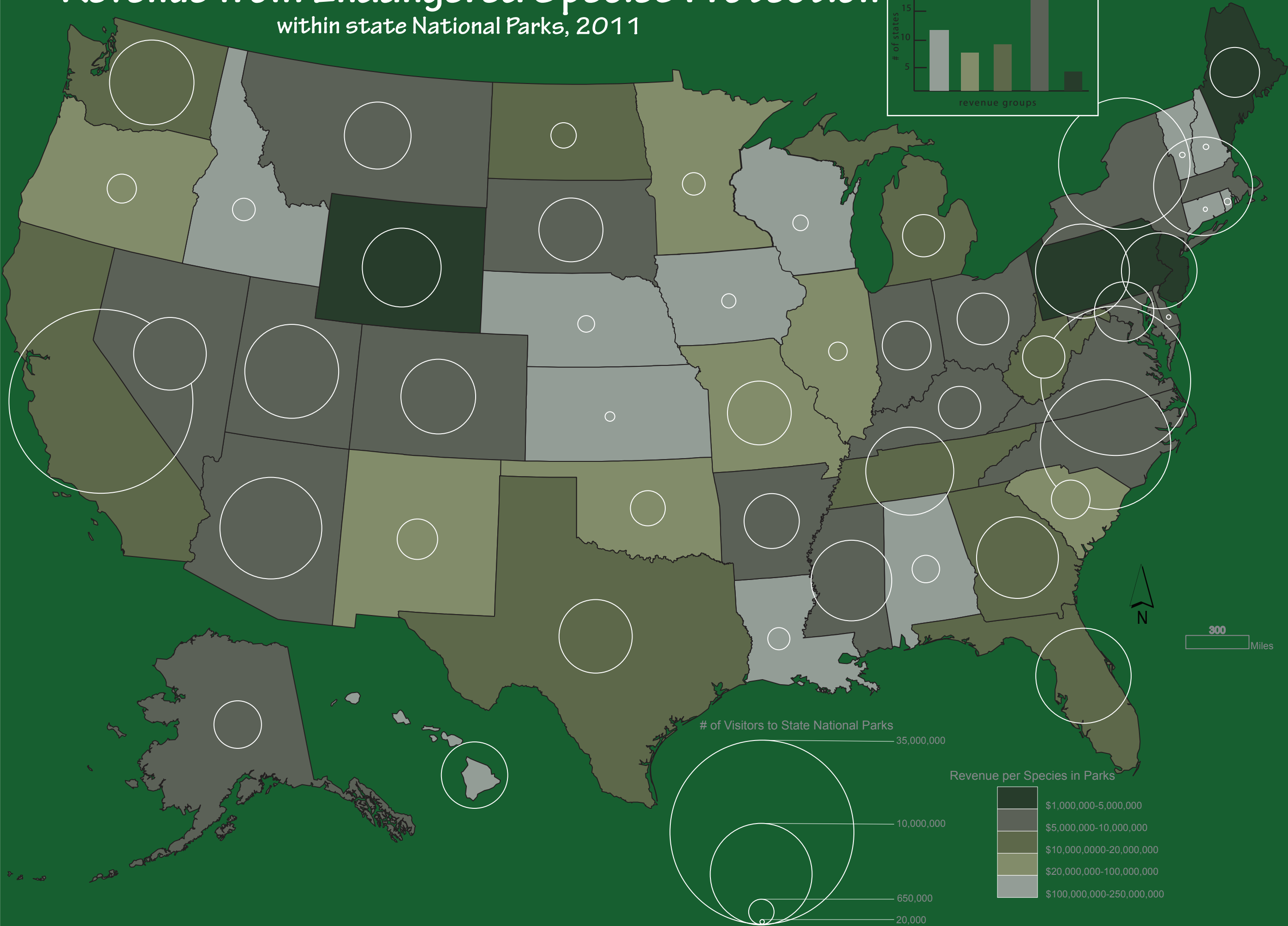
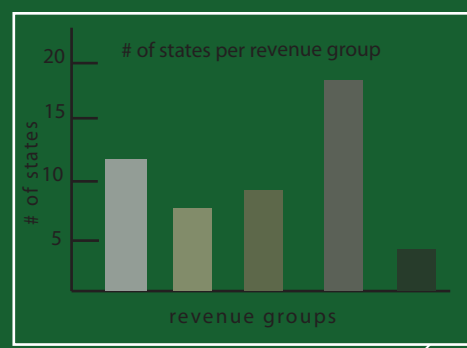
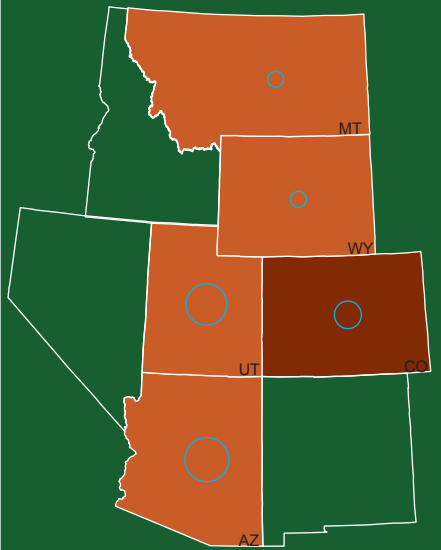


Revenue from Endangered Species Protection

States with a greater % of NP lands are able to support more species habitat. The draw of these keystone species brings more tourists and generates greater revenue for the state. This is contrasted by the Midwest states that have converted more land for agriculture use and the Western states that tend to have more park land.
