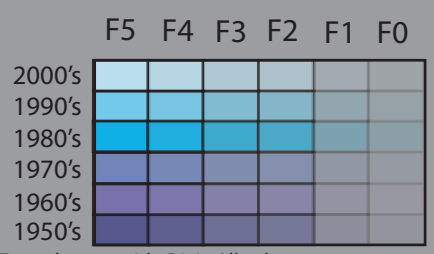


Dixie Alley, similar to Tornado Alley with a high frequency of tornadoes, has recently become a more popular area of study in determining not only tornado production, but also general tornado trends. In this graphic of over 60 years of tornadoes, higher F-scale tornadoes have made a shift from southern Mississippi to northern Alabama. A secondary hot spot of recent, low F-scale tornadoes can also be found in central Arkansas.
