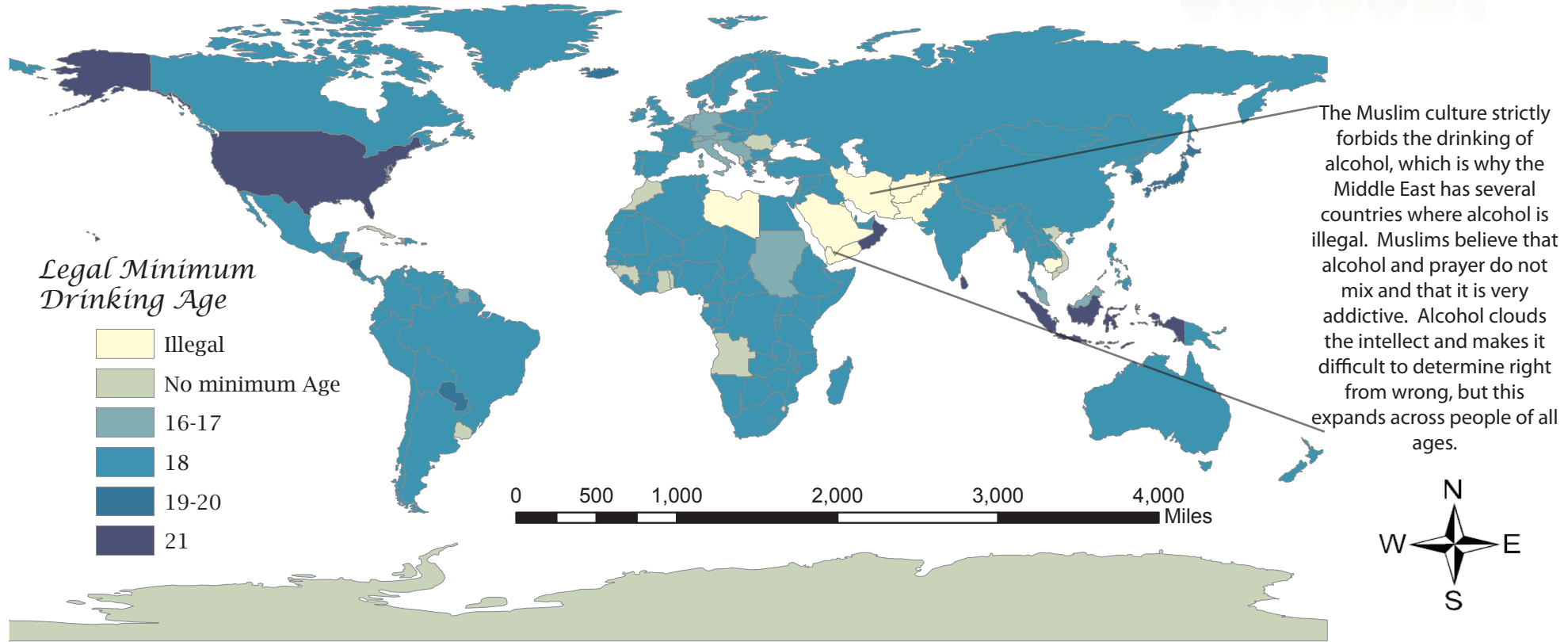
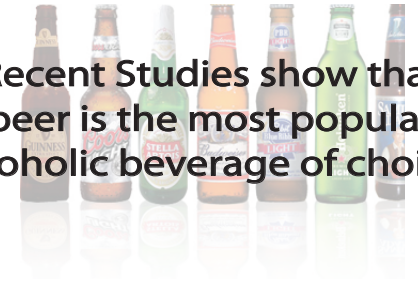


Are the Older Really Wiser?
