

# Food Sources in Madison:

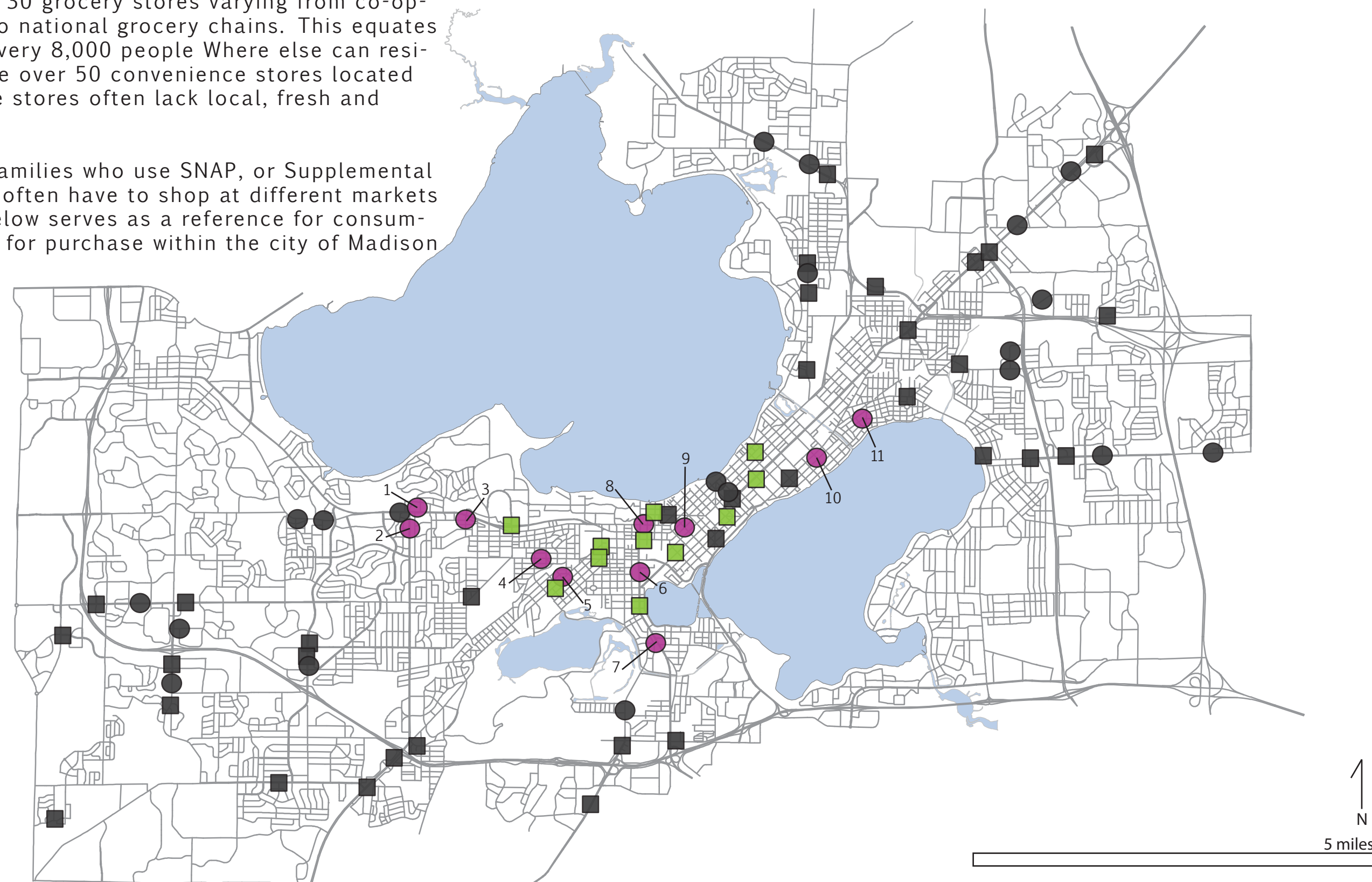
## A look at Grocery Store and Convenience Store Locations in the City of Madison

As of 2014, the city of Madison is home to over 240,000 people. Throughout the city, there are 30 grocery stores varying from co-operatives to ethic food stores to national grocery chains. This equates to about 1 grocery store for every 8,000 people. Where else can residents get their food? There are over 50 convenience stores located throughout Madison, but these stores often lack local, fresh and quality products.

Additionally, individuals and families who use SNAP, or Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, often have to shop at different markets that accept SNAP. The map below serves as a reference for consumers on where food is available for purchase within the city of Madison and highlights grocers who accept SNAP.
