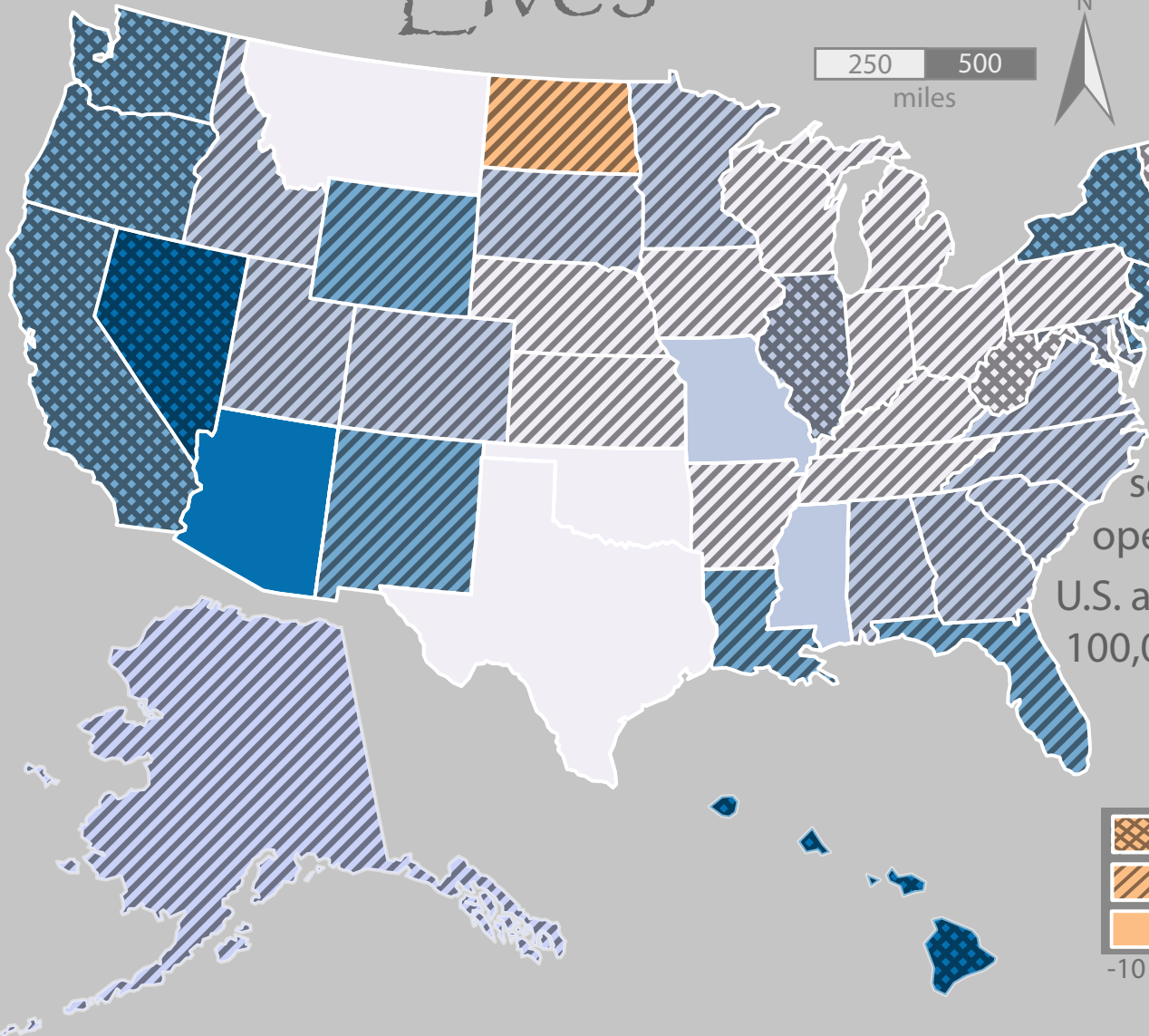
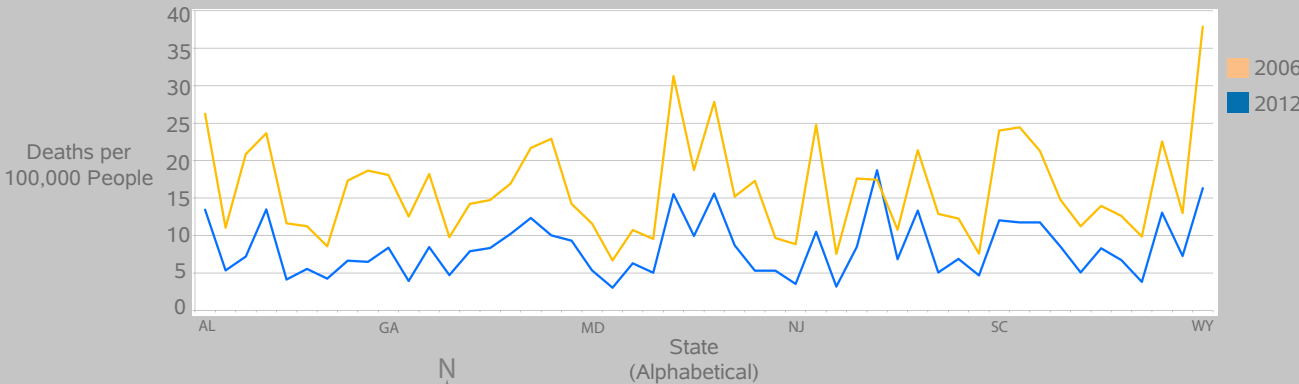


Cell Phone Laws Save Lives



In the United States, the first law banning the use of cell phones while driving was passed in 2007. The year prior, the U.S. averaged **SIXTEEN** highway deaths per 100,000 people. In 2012, there were only 6 states without a law banning some sort of cell phone use while operating a motor vehicle. That year, the U.S. averaged **EIGHT** highway deaths per 100,000 people.
