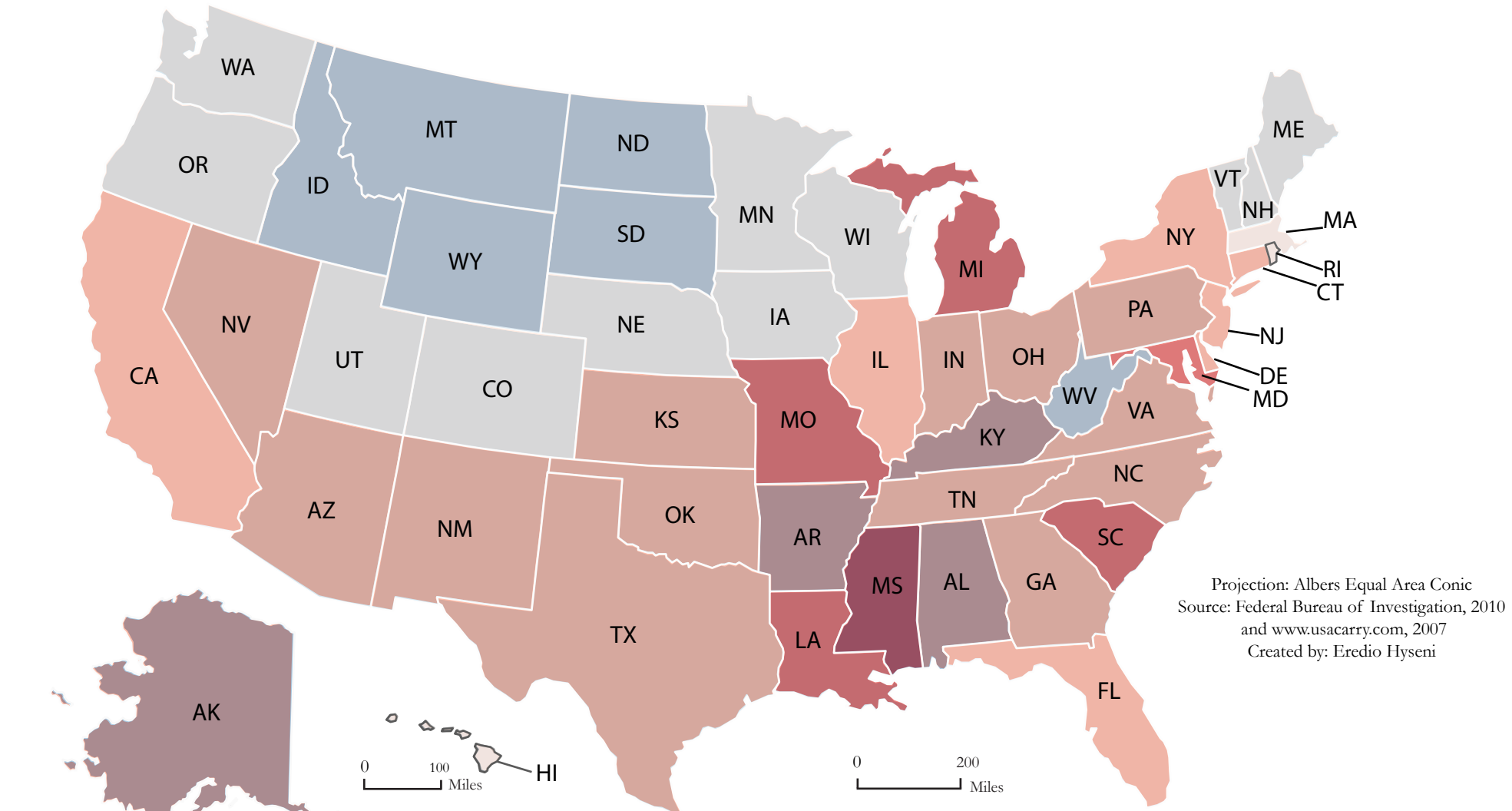


Do Gun Owners Make America Unsafe?

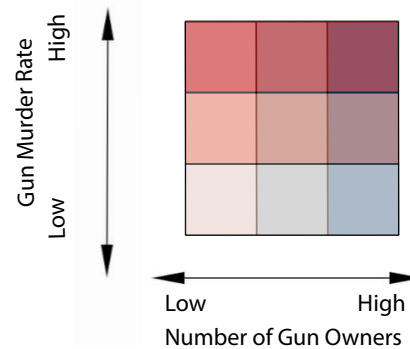
A comparison between gun ownership and the rate of gun murder in each state



Important Info:

A reasonable amount of gun related murders happen through the use of unregistered firearms and can therefore mislead someone to believe that a high rate of **registered** gun ownership can lead to gun murder when that is not the case.

It seems that one cannot draw a distinct correlation between these two variables by looking at this map. For whatever reason that it may be, the northern and southern states are quite polar opposites of each other on this topic.



Additional Information:

“High” Gun Murder Rate: Greater than 4 and up to 7.7 murders per 100,000 inhabitants.

Lowest Gun Murder Rate: 0.6

“High” Gun Ownership: Greater than 47,700 and up to 59,700 gun owners per 100,000 inhabitants.

Lowest Gun Ownership: 6,700 gun owners per 100,000
