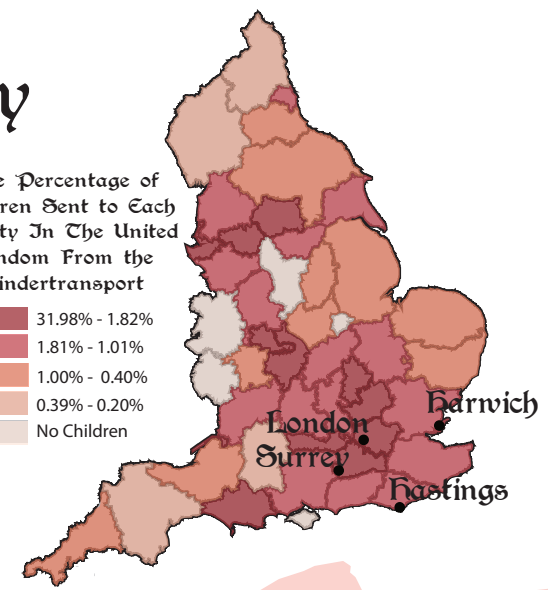
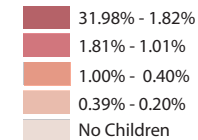


Kindertransport: Pen's Story

The Kindertransport took place from December 1938 to September 1939, right before and partly during WWII. The Kindertransport consisted of sending children, who were at risk of being taken by the Nazis, to safe countries. There were over 10,000 children involved in the Kindertransport, Pen being one of them. Pen was born in January of 1924 in Vienna. Right as the war started he became a part of the Kindertransport and this is the map of his story.

2. He arrived in the Hook of Holland on the 13th of March. From the Hook of Holland he boarded a ship that took him to Harwich where almost all children of the Kindertransport are taken and sent their separate ways.

3. After two days of traveling he made it to Harwich on the 15th of March.

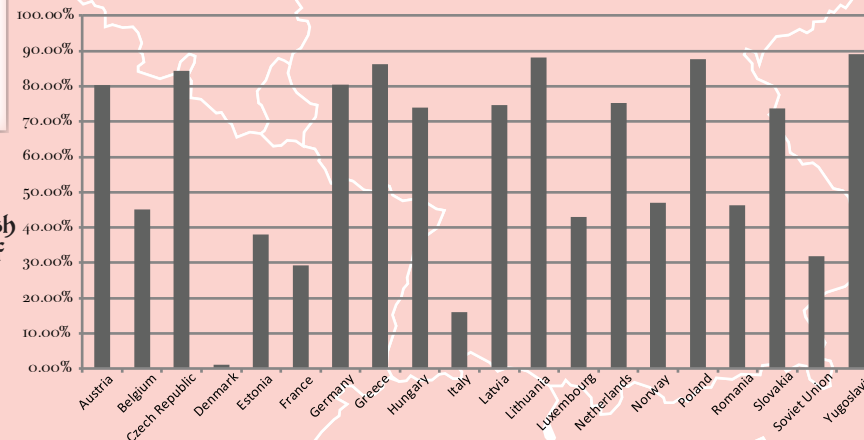
6. In 1948 Pen got married in London, his home to this day.

5. Then he was sent to Surrey where he lived with a foster family, the Cowlands, for two years from 1940 to 1942. It was during this time that he received the sad news of his parents death. They had been killed in a death camp.

4. He was fortunate to have family friends living in Hastings where he was able to stay for a year until 1940.

1. On the 13th of March in 1939 Pen was one of the first children to be placed in the Kindertransport. At the age of 15 he was sent away from his home and family in Vienna and boarded a train to the Hook Of Holland.
