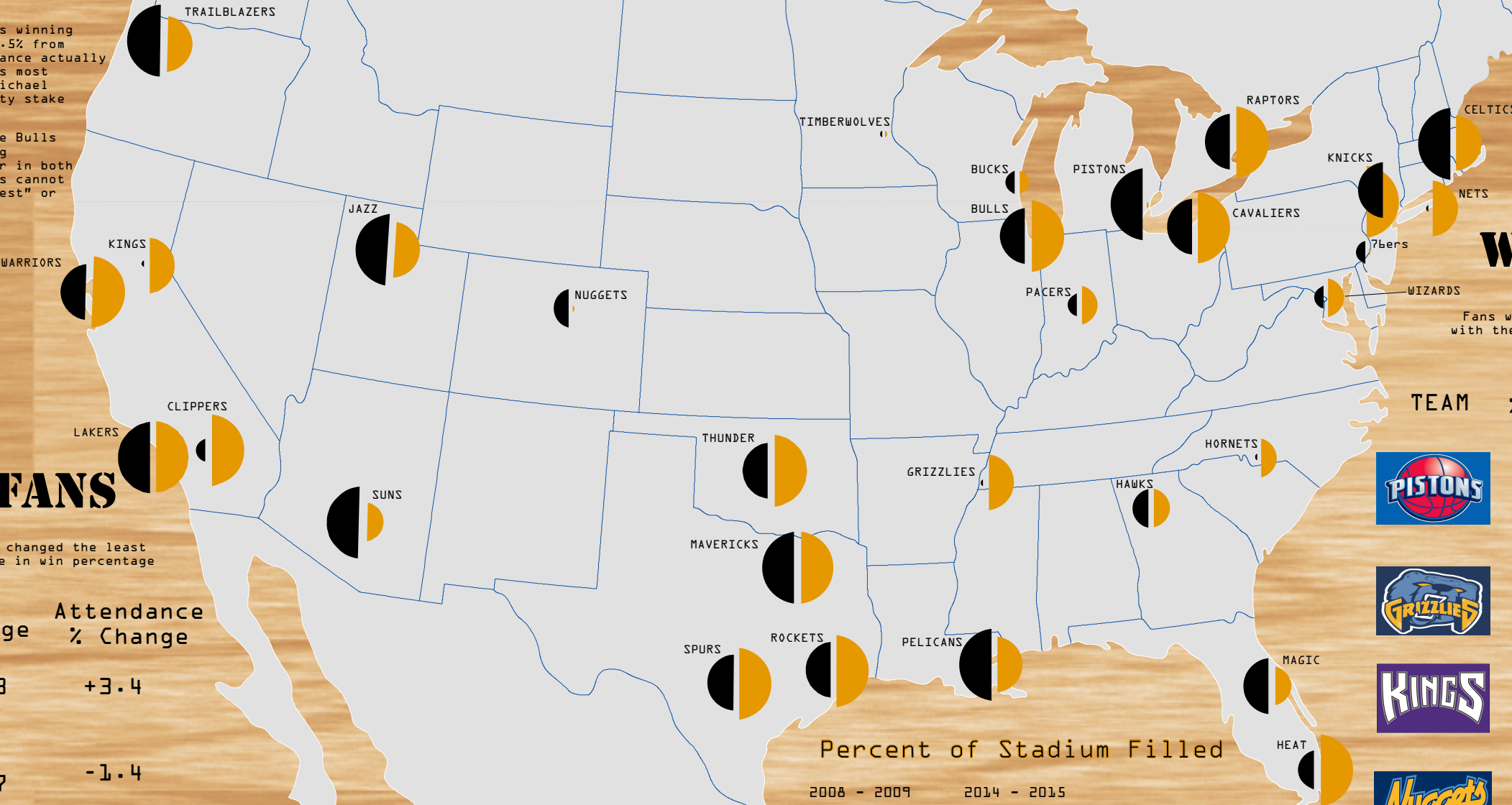
Fans who only attend games or show support for their team when they are performing well

INTERESTING TRENDS

-NETS: Despite having only a slightly better winning percentage in 2015(+4.8) than in 2009, their attendance went up by 18.3%. This must be attributed to the teams move from New Jersey to Brooklyn, NY.

-HORNETS: While the Hornets winning percentage went down by -2.5% from 2009 to 2015, their attendance actually increased by 13.8%. This is most likely due to NBA legend Michael Jordan purchasing a majority stake of the team in 2010.

Fans whose attendance changed the least with their teams change in win percentage

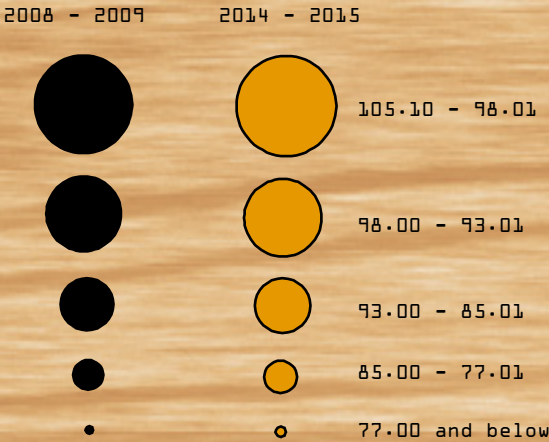
