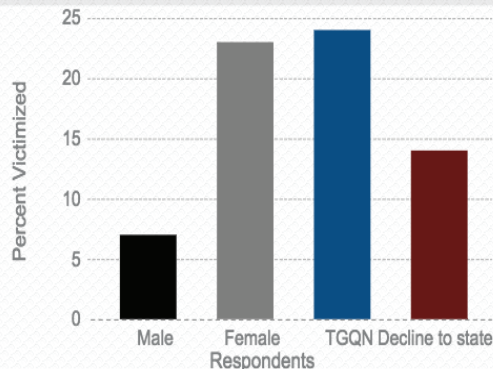


AAU SEXUAL ASSAULT SURVEY

Key Findings

PERCENT REPORTING SEXUAL CONTACT INVOLVING PHYSICAL FORCE OR INCAPACITATION SINCE ENROLLING IN THE COLLEGE



This bar graph showcases the increase in sexual contact involving physical force or incapacitation since enrolling in college. TGQN (Transgender, Genderqueer or non-conforming, questioning or not listed) were the most impacted with a 24% increase since entering college and females coming in a close second with 23%.

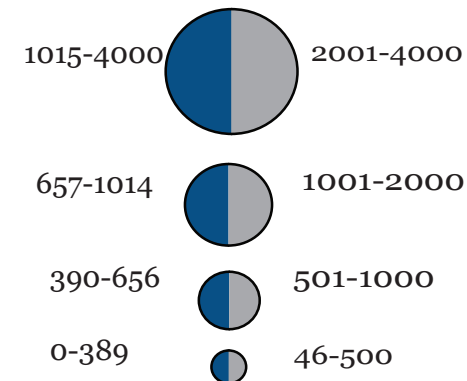
28% of undergraduate women said they were victims of non-consensual sexual contact through force. Among undergraduate men, the rate was 5%.
