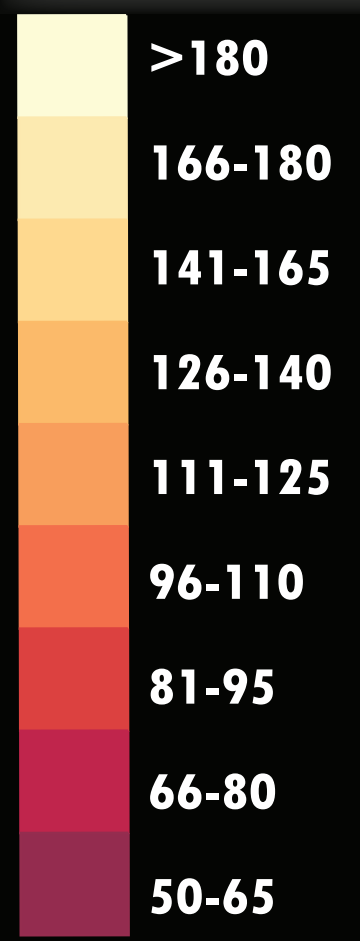

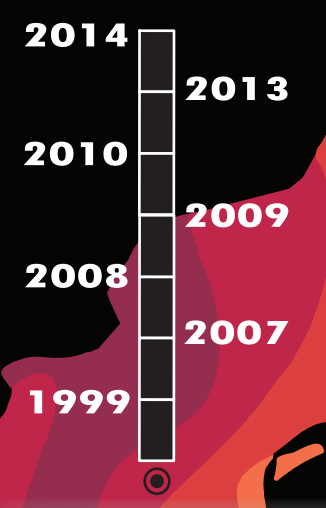
[DOES MORE SUN LEAD TO MORE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS IN VOLLEYBALL?]

[AVERAGE ANNUAL NUMBER OF CLEAR DAYS]

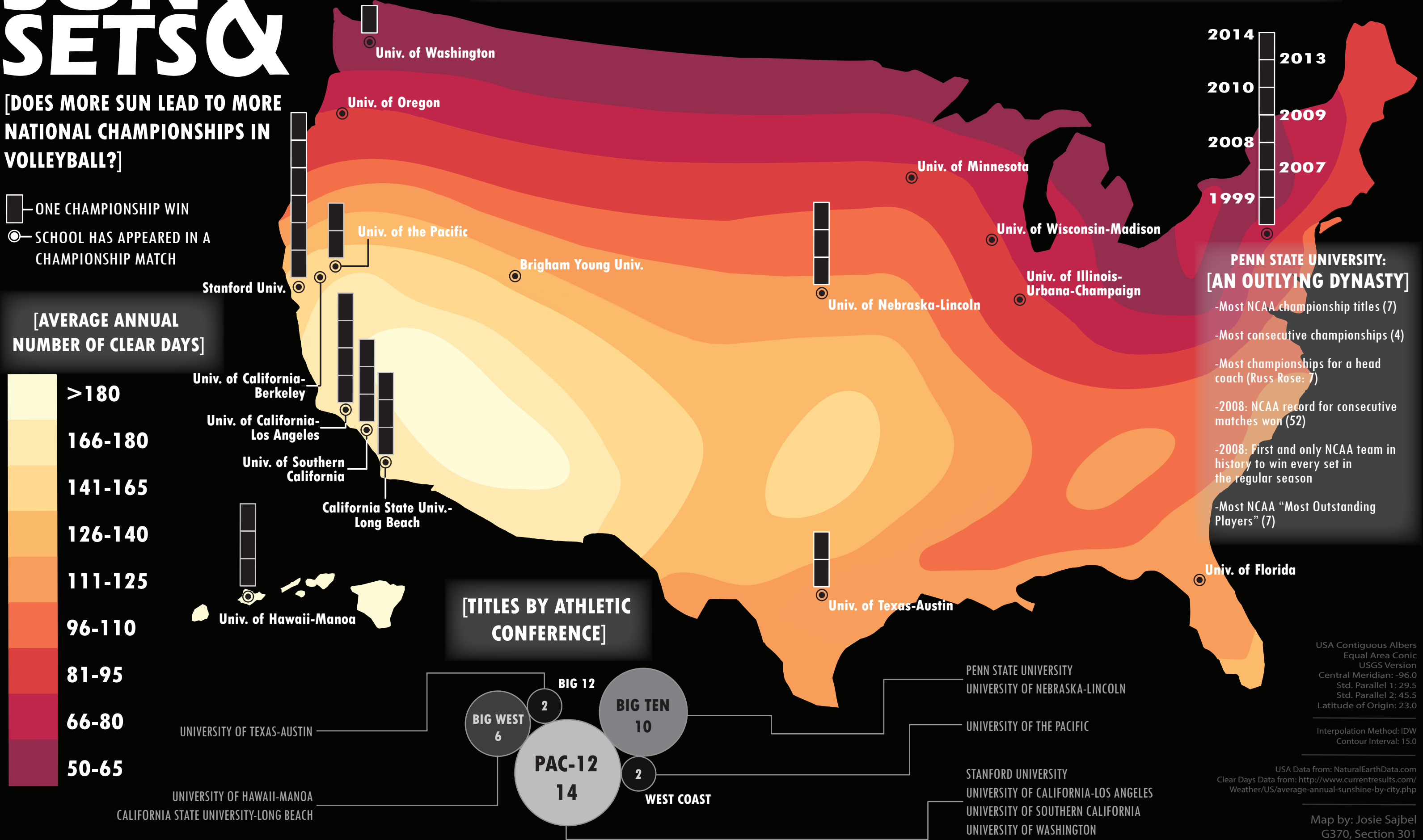


[NUMBER OF NCAA DI WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS BY UNIVERSITY]

- Most consecutive championships (4)
- Most championships for a head coach (Russ Rose: 7)
- 2008: NCAA record for consecutive matches won (52)
- 2008: First and only NCAA team in history to win every set in the regular season
- Most NCAA "Most Outstanding Players" (7)
