


Major Terrorist Attacks in Europe, 2010-2018

2011 NORWAY ATTACKS




Solo right-wing terrorist Anders Behring Breivik committed two attacks in southern Norway; a car bombing and a mass shooting. 77 people were killed.

2017 MANCHESTER BOMBING

A radical Islamist detonated a shrapnel bomb following a concert at the Manchester Arena by Ariana Grande. 23 people were killed by the bombing.

NOVEMBER 2015 PARIS ATTACKS

A series of Jihadist attacks committed by ISIL on the night of November 13, 2015. The six different attacks included mass shootings in addition to suicide bombings. 130 people were killed in the attacks.



NOTES: "Major terrorist attack" includes attacks with 2 or more deaths. 2010 recorded no major terrorist attacks. Data for Russia and Ukraine is not included due to the occurrence of war there since 2014.
