THE WESTERN EFFECT: Comparing Terror Incident Media Coverage to the Total Number of Terror Incidents

Terrorism occurs all over the world, with especially devasting effects to civilians. In 2015 alone, there were 14,965 terror-related incidents.Yet, New York Times media coverage of terror incidents distorts public perception, leading many to believe Western countries are the primary targets of terrorism. Instead, most terror incidents occured in the Middle East, Africa, and Asia. The New York Times's selective media coverage of terror incidents is dangerous to public perception of terrorism because it ignores the effects of terrorism outside of the Western viewpoint. *Countries with a high number of terror incidents are labeled.
