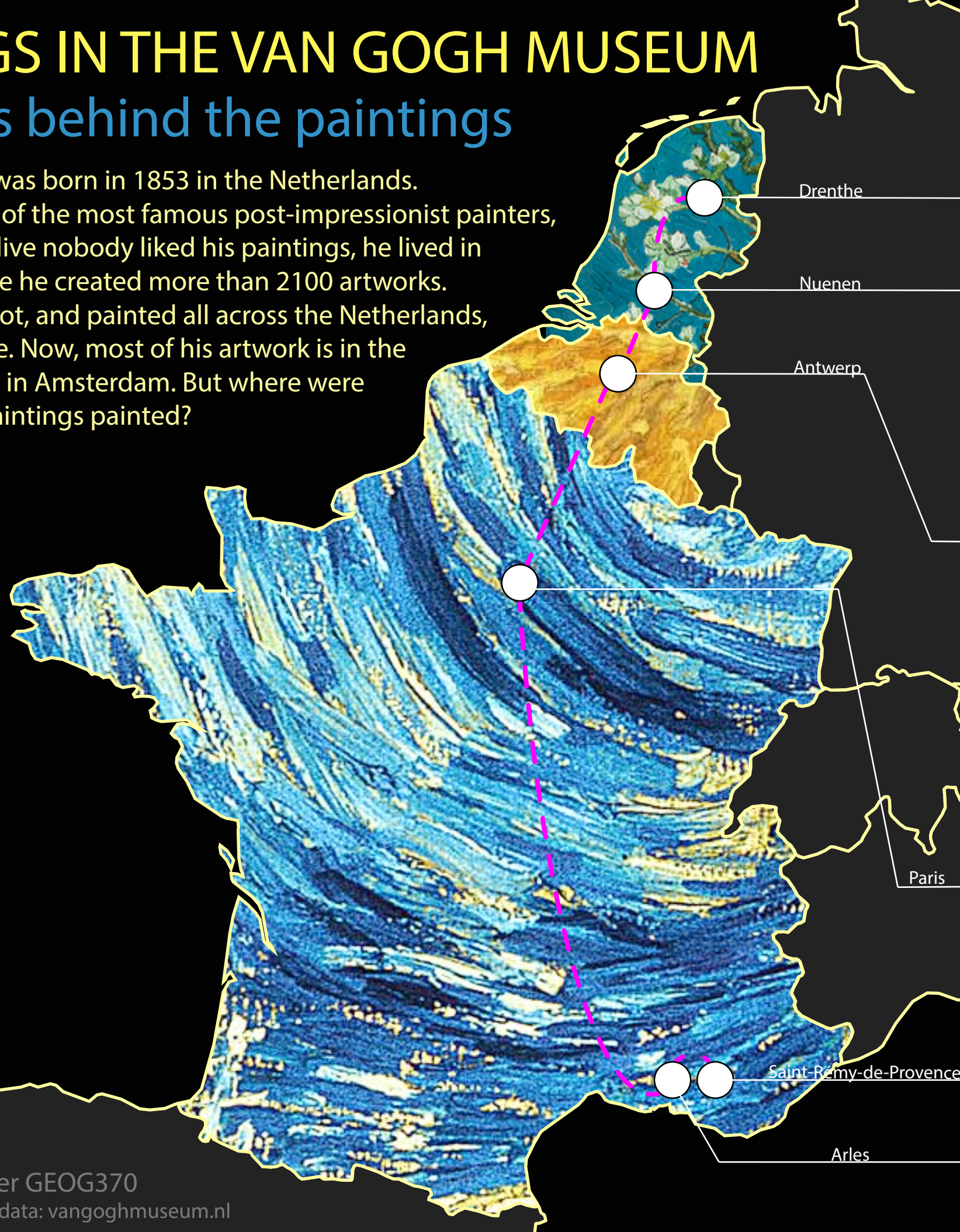


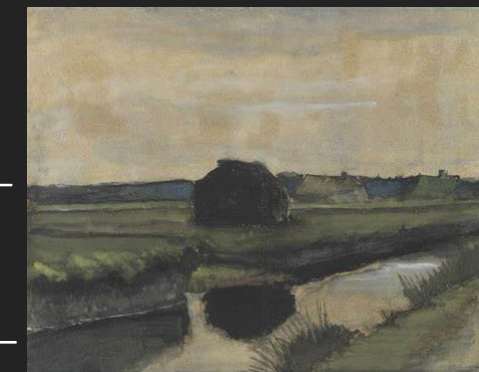
# PAINTINGS IN THE VAN GOGH MUSEUM

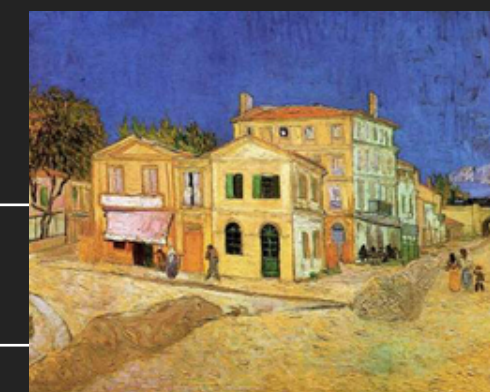
