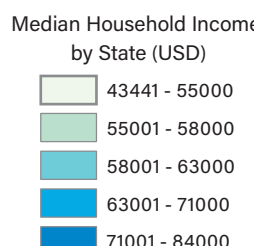
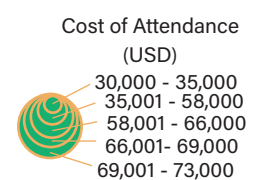
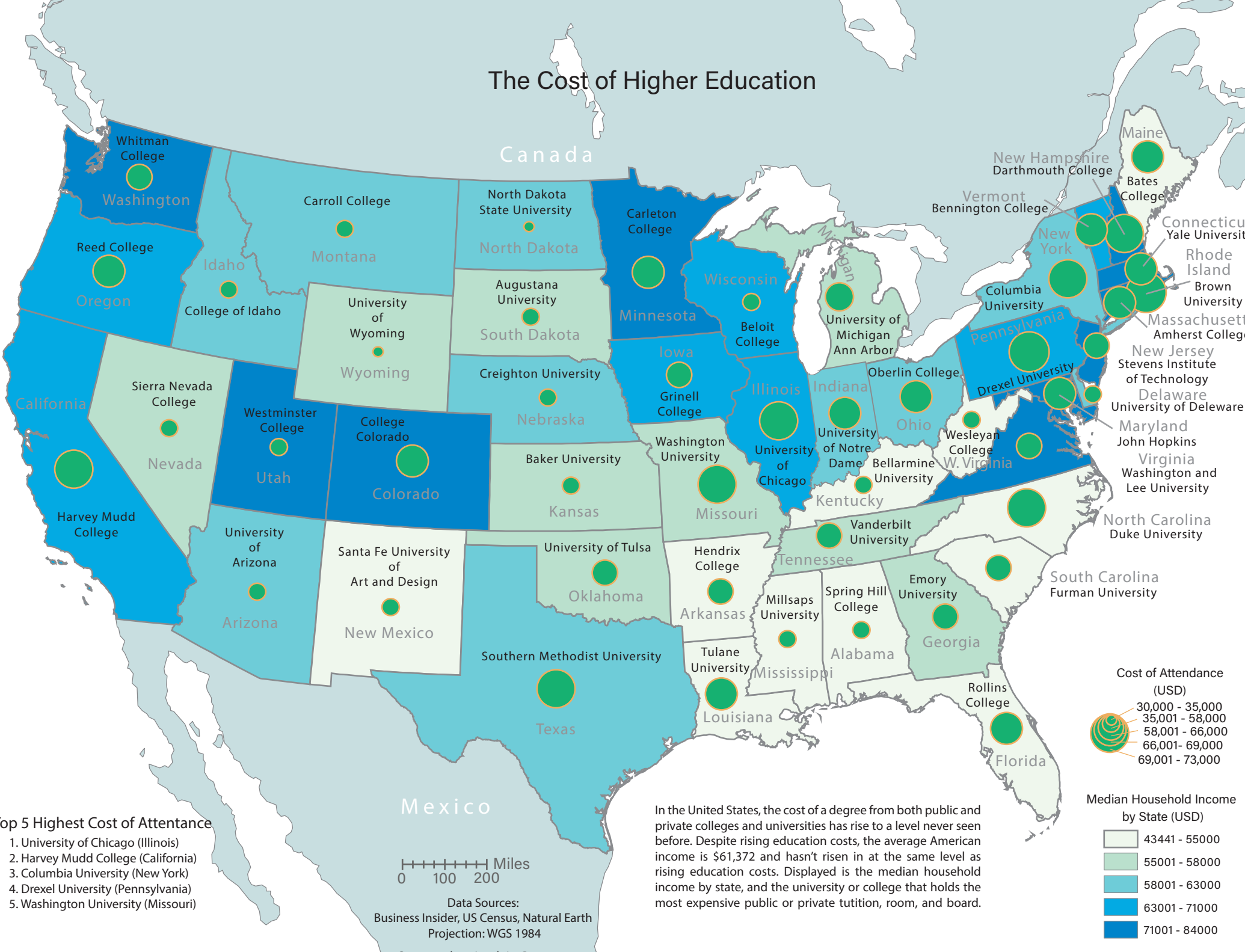
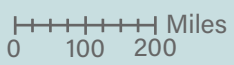


The Cost of Higher Education
