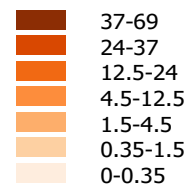
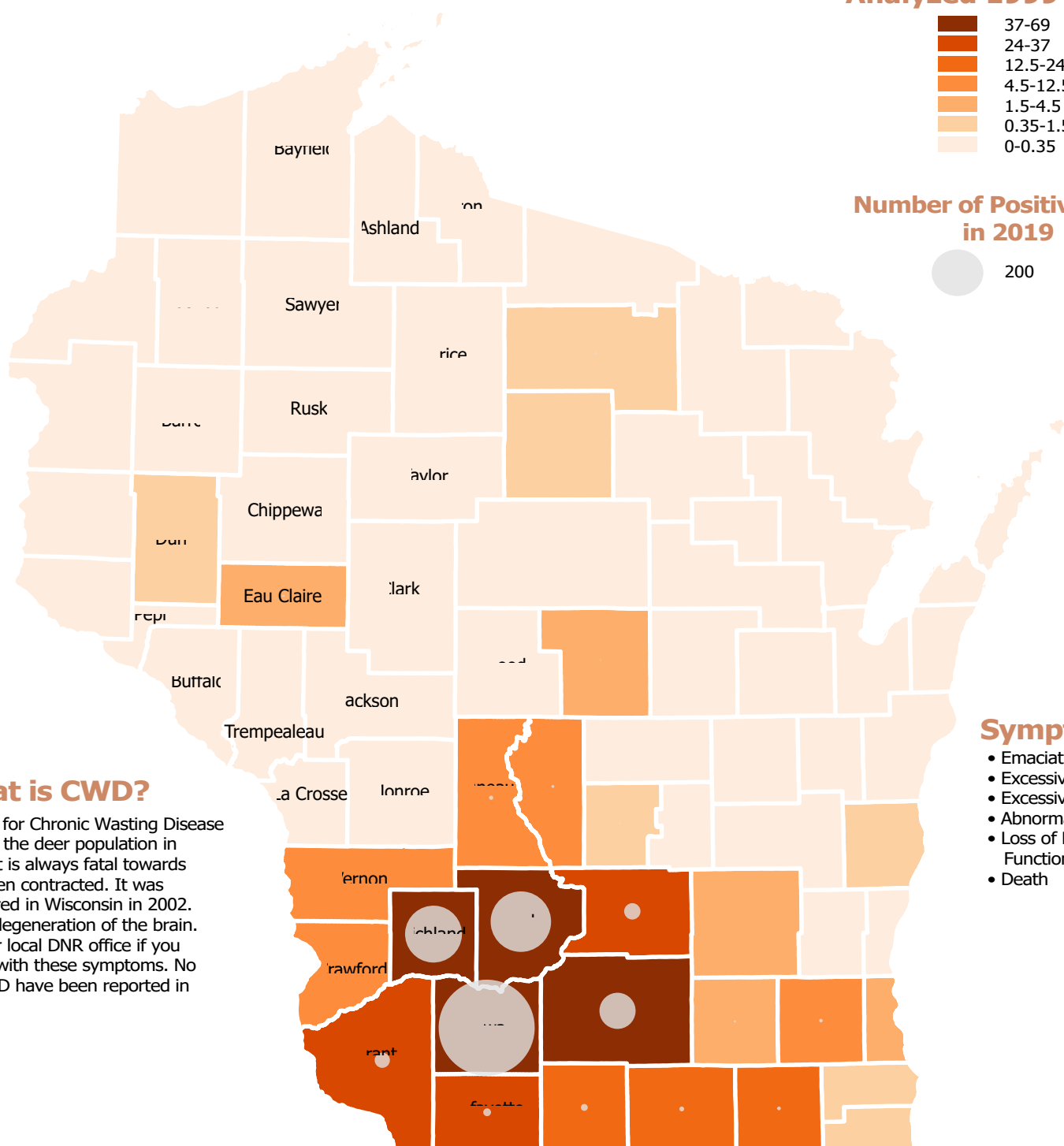


Historical and Current Prevalence of CWD in Deer
