The 7 Days Trip around The Golden Circle on Wheels

Day 7: Ísafjörður

Bunárfoss: A beautiful waterfall that is approximately 4 kilometers west from Ísafjörður in the Tungudalur valley. You can climb up the hill along the steep river with waterfall.

Back to Reykjavik and end this fantastic road trip!

Day 6: Sauðárkrúkur

Sauðárkrúkur is the largest town in Northwest Iceland with a population of 2,612. This is great place to soothe your mind in the natural geothermal pool.

Grettislaug pool: A geothermal pool that is about 39°C (100°F) year round. Located by the seaside with amazing views, this pool has been constructed with natural stones.

Day 5: Egilsstaðir

Egilsstaðir is the main centre for service, transportation and administration in East Iceland.

East Fjords: this is one of the most remote places in Iceland, and there will often be no other soul in sight except nesting puffins on the cliffs from afar.

Day 1-2: Reykjavík

Hallgrímskirkja Church: The beautiful basalt columns at Svartifoss waterfall inspired the church's architecture. The concert organ is 15m tall, has 5275 pipes, and weighs 25 tons. This church is open daily, except on Sundays, when there are mass services.

Fermented Shark(Hákarl): A local food that contains a large amount of ammonia and has a strong smell. It is often eaten with a shot of the local spirit, a type of akvavit called Brennivín.
