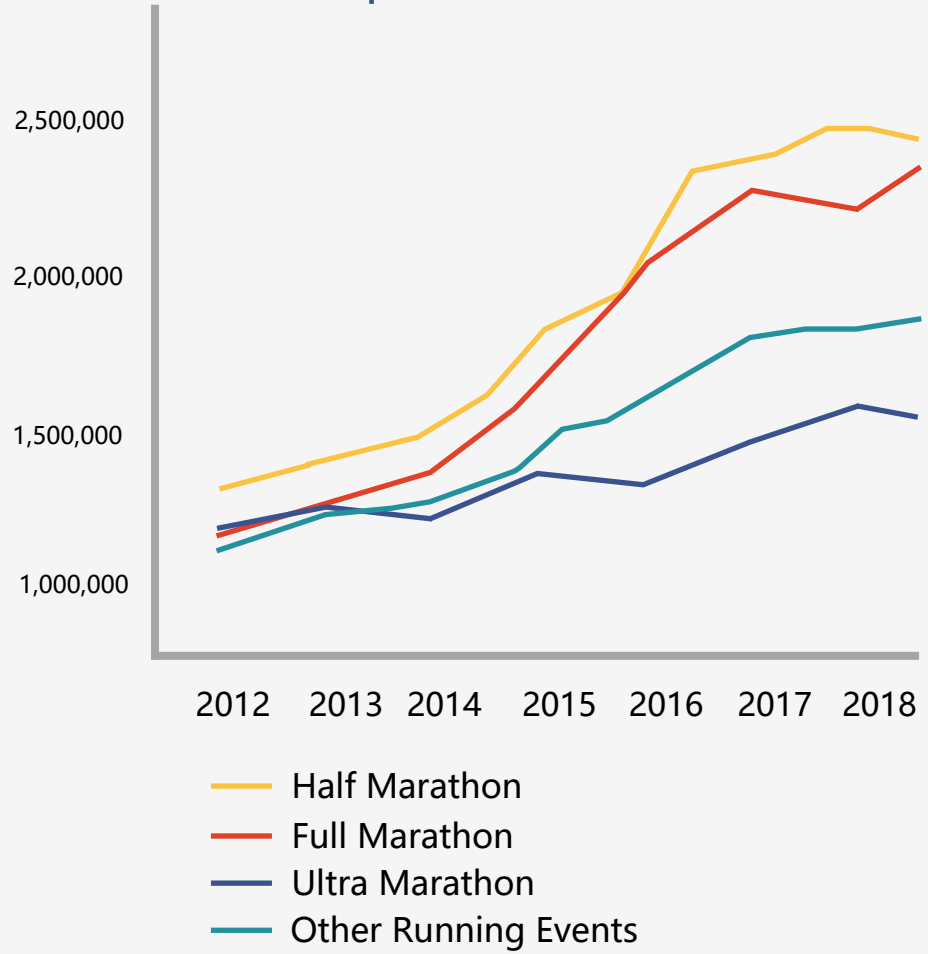

Marathon running is popular, and is becoming more popular during the years. The growth from 2008 to 2018 was +49.43%. Women are picking up faster than men with a growth of +56.83% while men's participation rate has increased +46.91%.

The first "World's Best" recognized by the International Association of Athletics Federations was recorded in Chicago Marathon in 1999 by Khalid Khannouchi with a grade of 2:05:37.8

The largest marathon race in US is the TCS marathon in NYC, it has more than 50,000 finishers.

Black Mountain Marathon is one of the most difficult marathon races in US, with a highest altitude of 5,340'. It attracts many hard-core runners every year.

The Daytona Beach is a flat and fast course, perhaps the fastest ultra marathon in the country. With the moderate-to-cool North Florida temperatures in December this course is absolutely perfect for anyone looking to run a first 100-miler, or to notch a "PR" in the distance.
