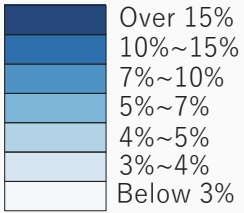


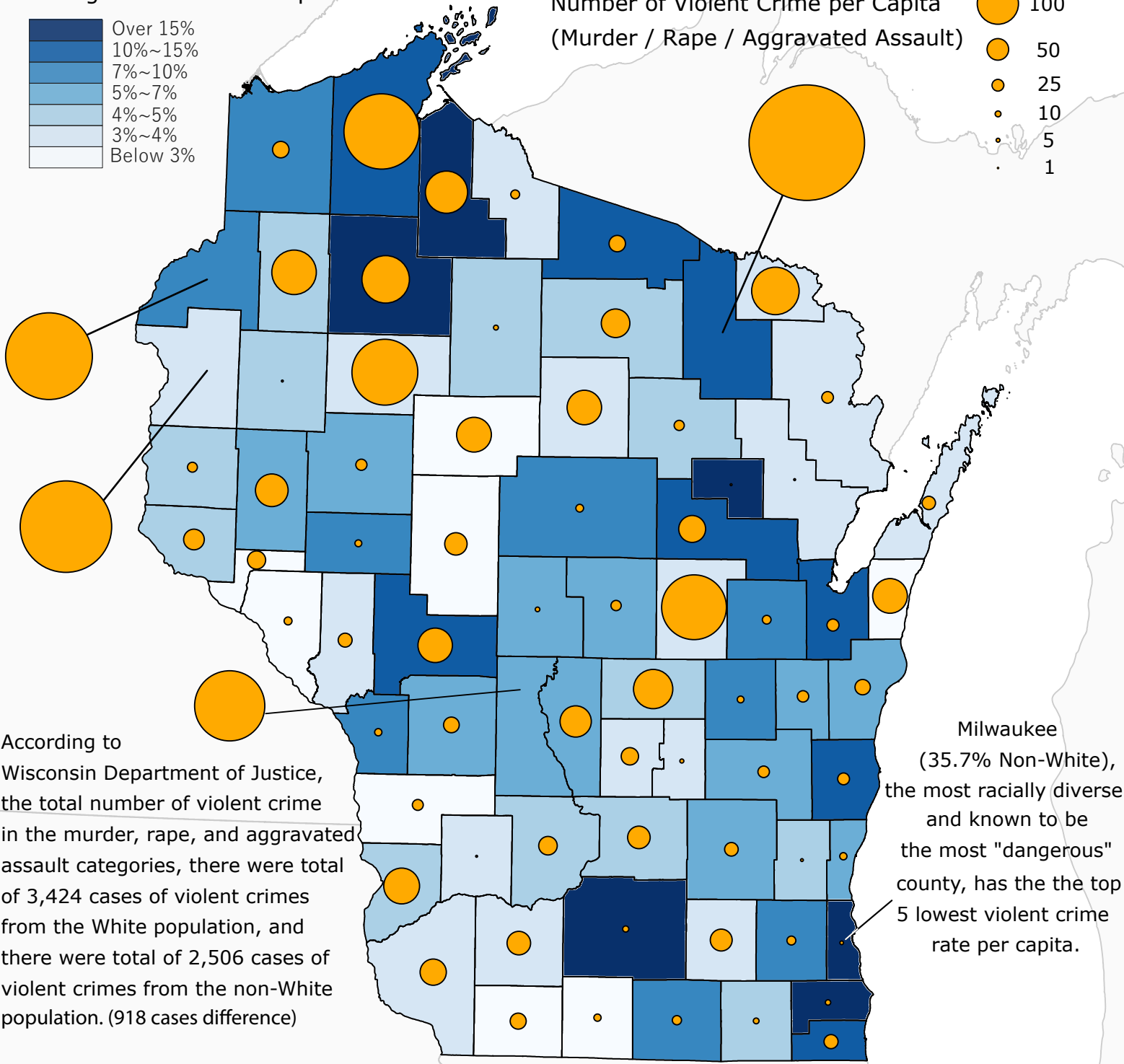
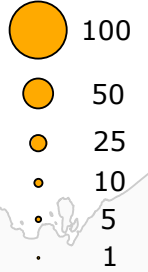
# "ARE NON-WHITE COMMUNITIES ACTUALLY MORE DANGEROUS?"

The general public has a notion of communities of predominantly non-white population being more "dangerous". But does more non-white population density actually mean more crime? I will let you be the judge with this map.

Number of Violent Crime per Capita  
(Murder / Rape / Aggravated Assault)



According to Wisconsin Department of Justice, the total number of violent crime in the murder, rape, and aggravated assault categories, there were total of 3,424 cases of violent crimes from the White population, and there were total of 2,506 cases of violent crimes from the non-White population. (918 cases difference)

Milwaukee (35.7% Non-White), the most racially diverse and known to be the most "dangerous" county, has the the top 5 lowest violent crime rate per capita.
