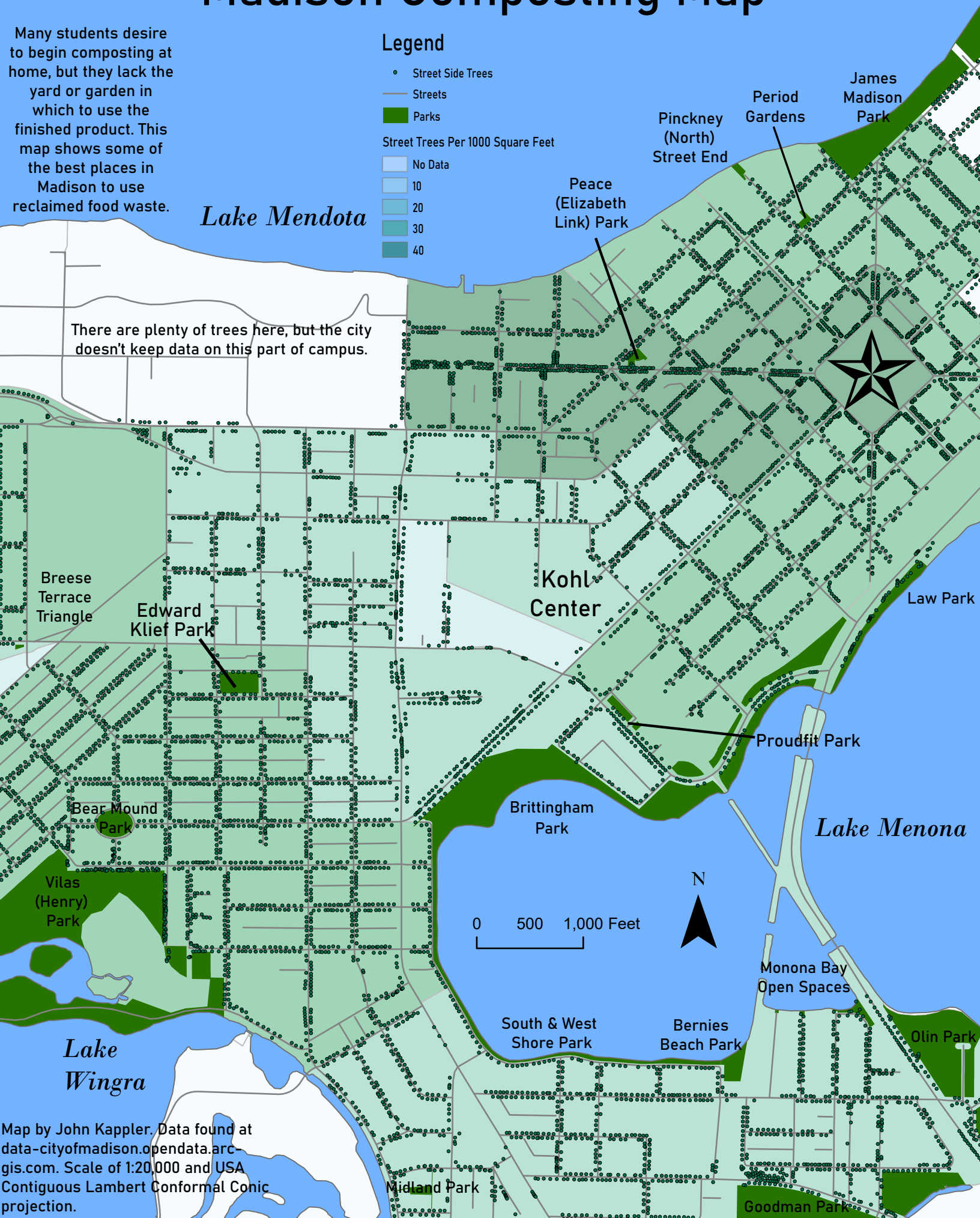


Madison Composting Map
