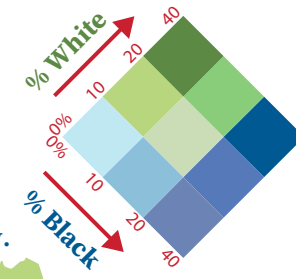






# COVID-19 Death Disparities By Race

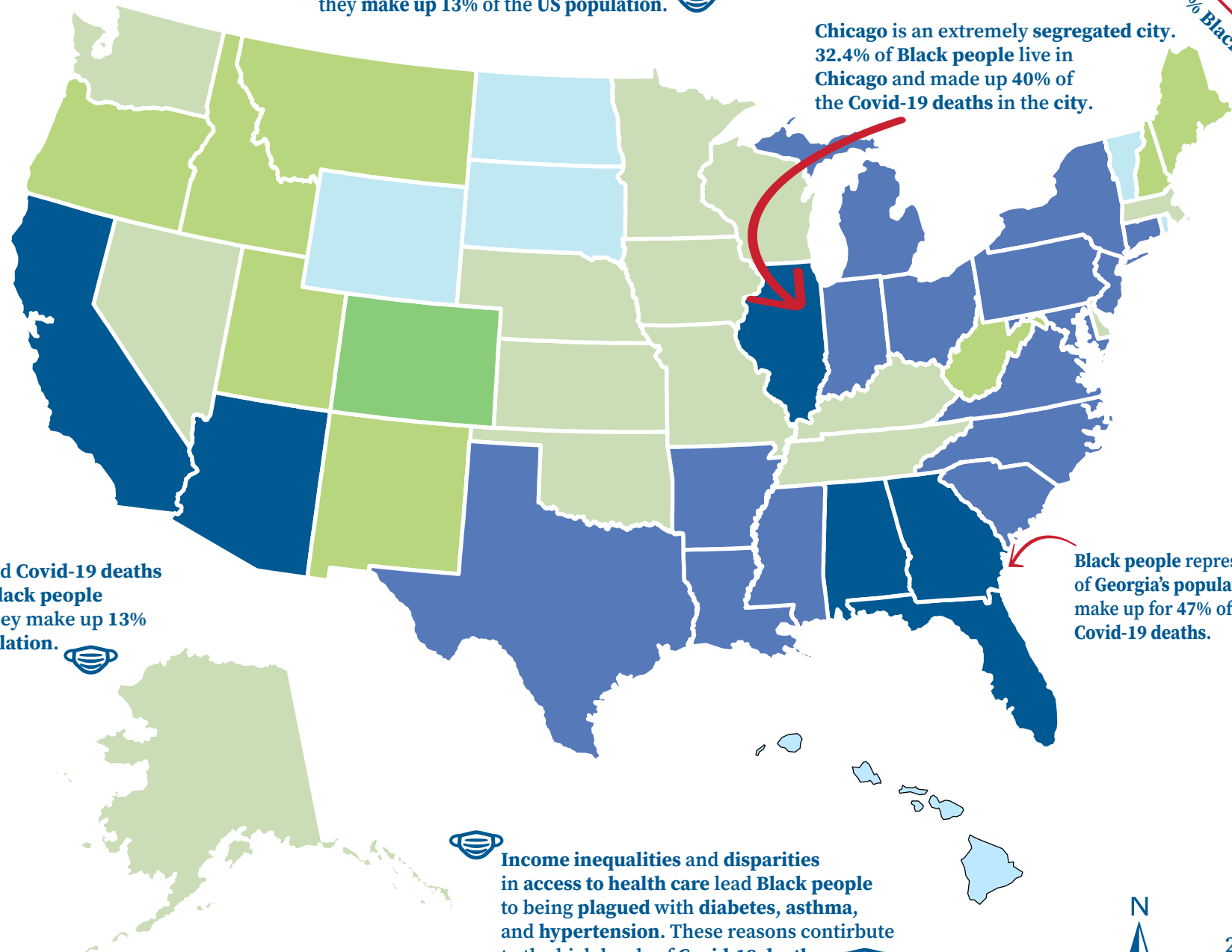


Covid-19 Deaths by Race





 23% of reported Covid-19 deaths have been of Black people even though they make up 13% of the US population. 

Chicago is an extremely segregated city. 32.4% of Black people live in Chicago and made up 40% of the Covid-19 deaths in the city.



 23% of reported Covid-19 deaths have been of Black people even though they make up 13% of the US population. 

Black people represent 32% of Georgia's population but make up for 47% of Covid-19 deaths.

 Income inequalities and disparities in access to health care lead Black people to being plagued with diabetes, asthma, and hypertension. These reasons contribute to the high levels of Covid-19 deaths.
