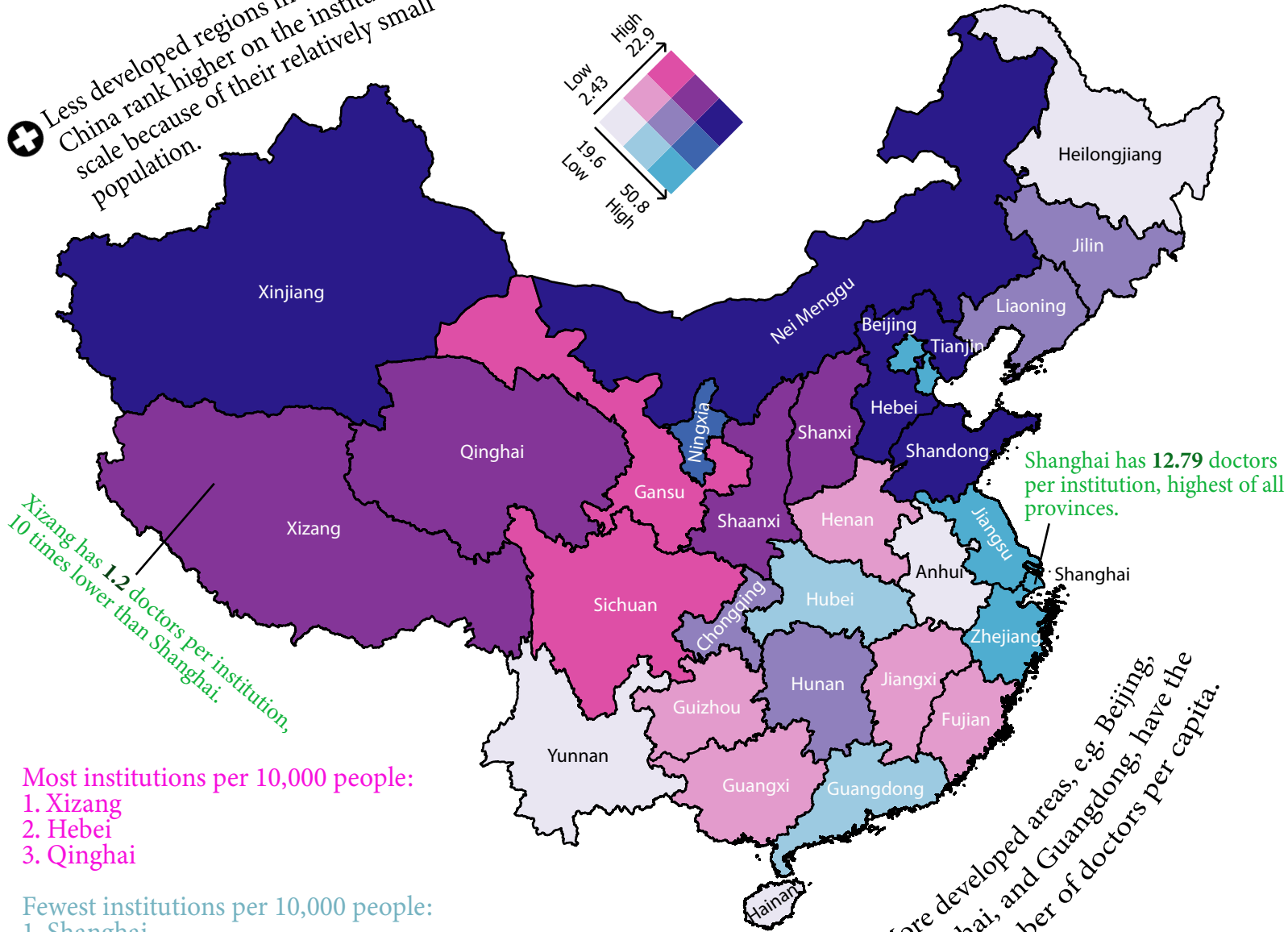
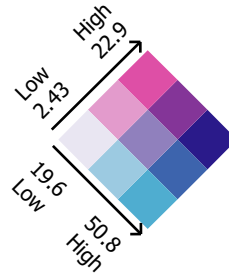

⊕ Less developed regions in northwest China rank higher on the institution scale because of their relatively small population.

doctor per 10,000 people



Xizang has 1.2 doctors per institution, 10 times lower than Shanghai.

Shanghai has 12.79 doctors per institution, highest of all provinces.

Most institutions per 10,000 people:

1. Xizang
2. Hebei
3. Qinghai

Fewest institutions per 10,000 people:

1. Shanghai
2. Jiangsu
3. Anhui

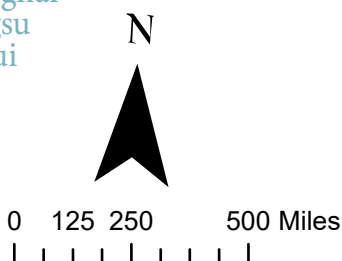
Most doctors per 10,000 people:

1. Beijing
2. Zhejiang
3. Tianjin

Fewest doctors per 10,000 people:

1. Jiangxi
2. Anhui
3. Yunnan

⊕ More developed areas, e.g. Beijing, Shanghai, and Guangdong, have the most number of doctors per capita.
