



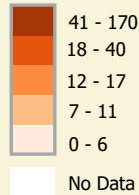

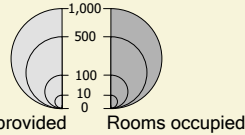

COVID-19 pandemic has broken out in California since March, 2020. The increased cases reached the first highest point in July. On July 23, there are 10647 new cases in California. In December, the increased cases reached the second highest point. With the restrictions of wearing masks and stay home order, daily new cases decreased in 2021. On April 6, the total new cases are only 2261.

Homeless is one of the social issues generated during the pandemic. Homeless people are concentrated in Bay area, including San Francisco and Los Angeles county. Project Roomkey, supported by local government, is the main project to provided shelter rooms.
