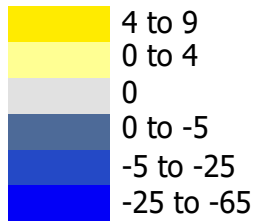
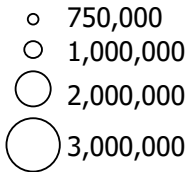

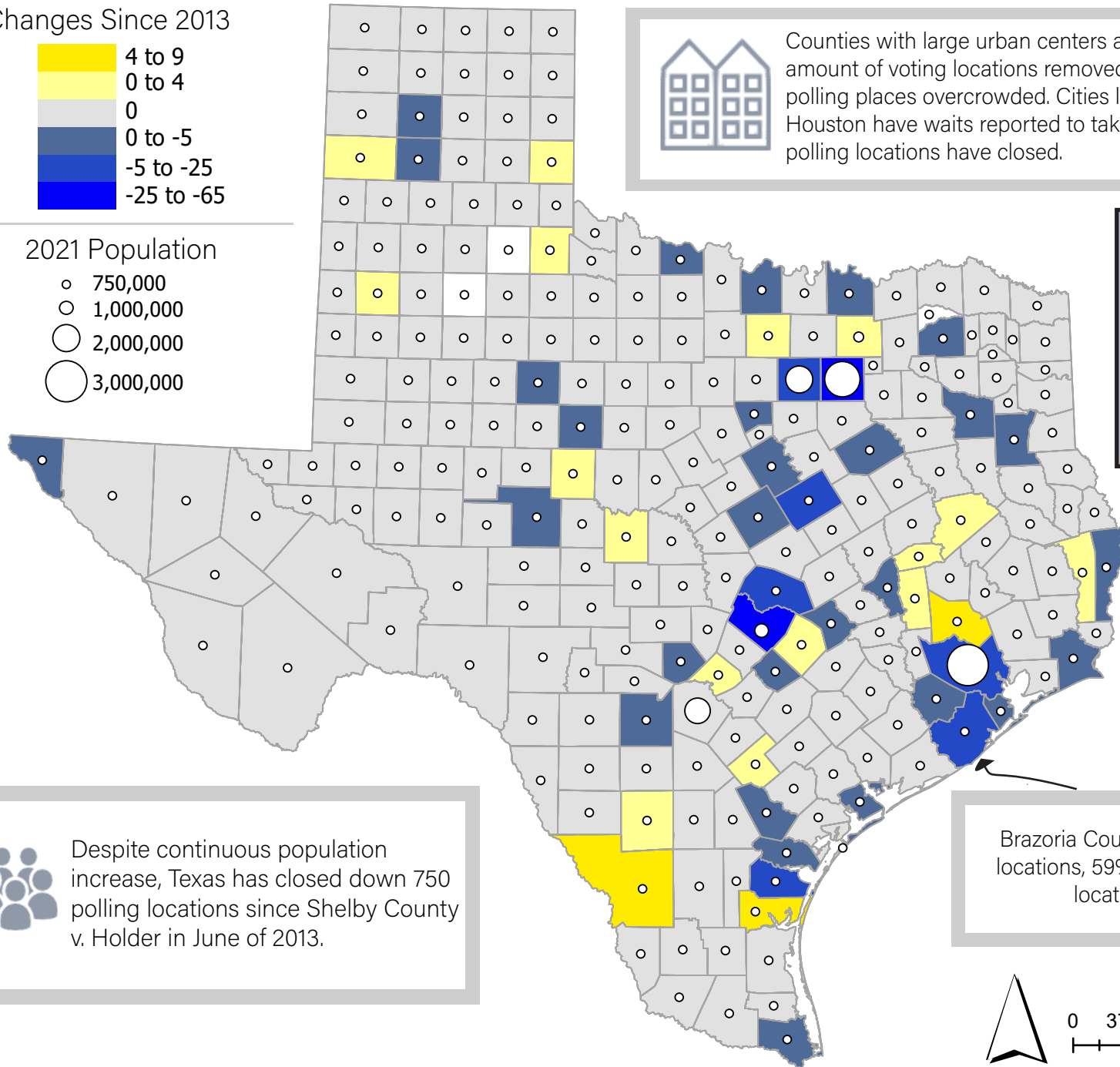


*Counties in white are missing data.



Counties with large urban centers are having the most amount of voting locations removed, leaving many polling places overcrowded. Cities like Dallas and Houston have waits reported to take hours after polling locations have closed.

Texas Shuts Down Voting Locations



Despite continuous population increase, Texas has closed down 750 polling locations since Shelby County v. Holder in June of 2013.

Brazoria County loses 37 polling locations, 59% less than the total locations in 2013
