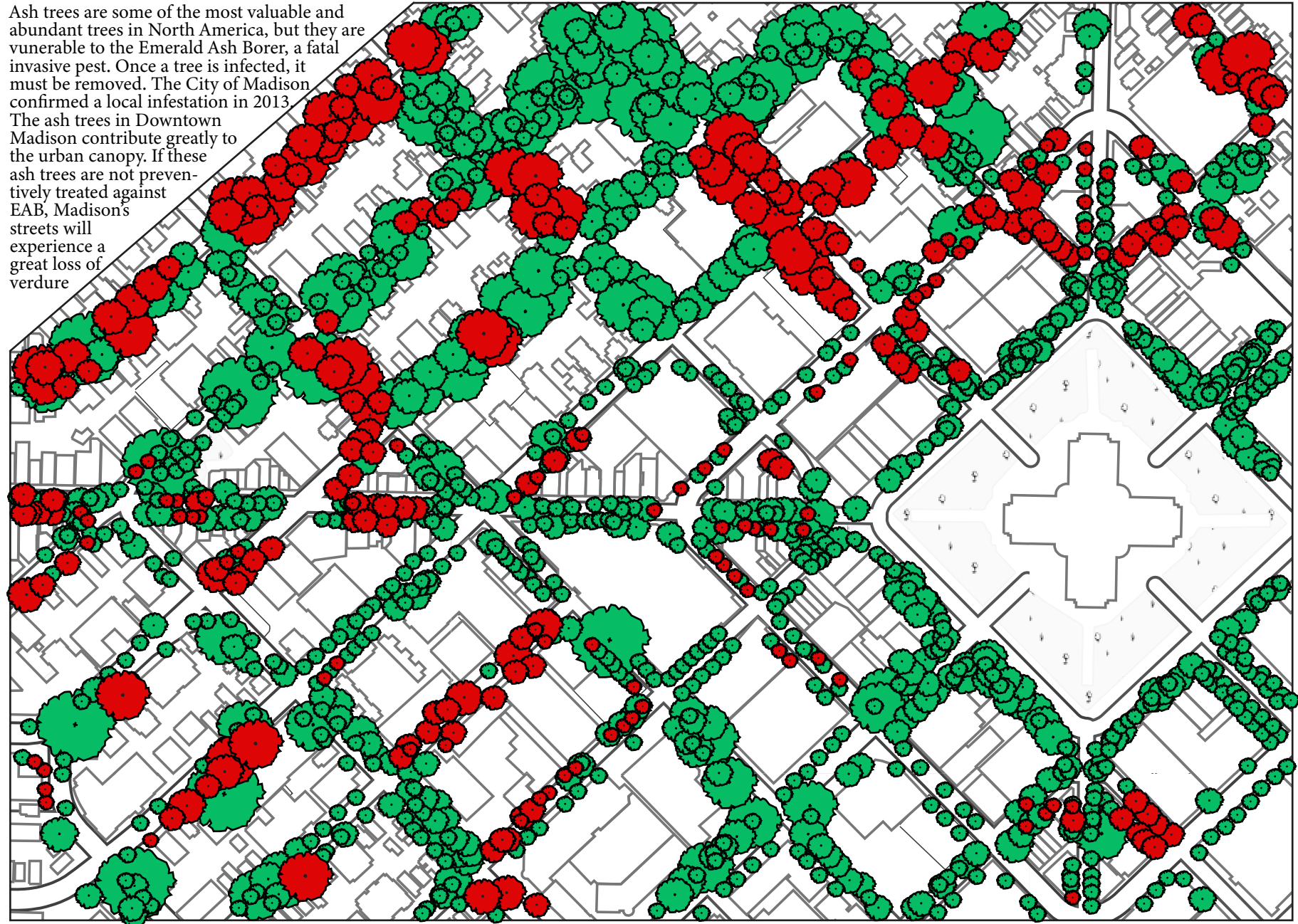


THREATENED ASH TREES IN DOWNTOWN MADISON, WISCONSIN

Ash trees are some of the most valuable and abundant trees in North America, but they are vulnerable to the Emerald Ash Borer, a fatal invasive pest. Once a tree is infected, it must be removed. The City of Madison confirmed a local infestation in 2013. The ash trees in Downtown Madison contribute greatly to the urban canopy. If these ash trees are not preventively treated against EAB, Madison's streets will experience a great loss of verdure
