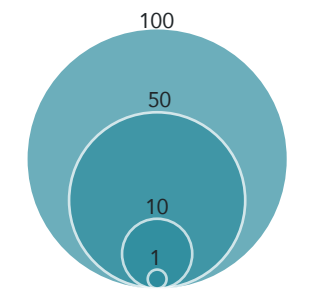
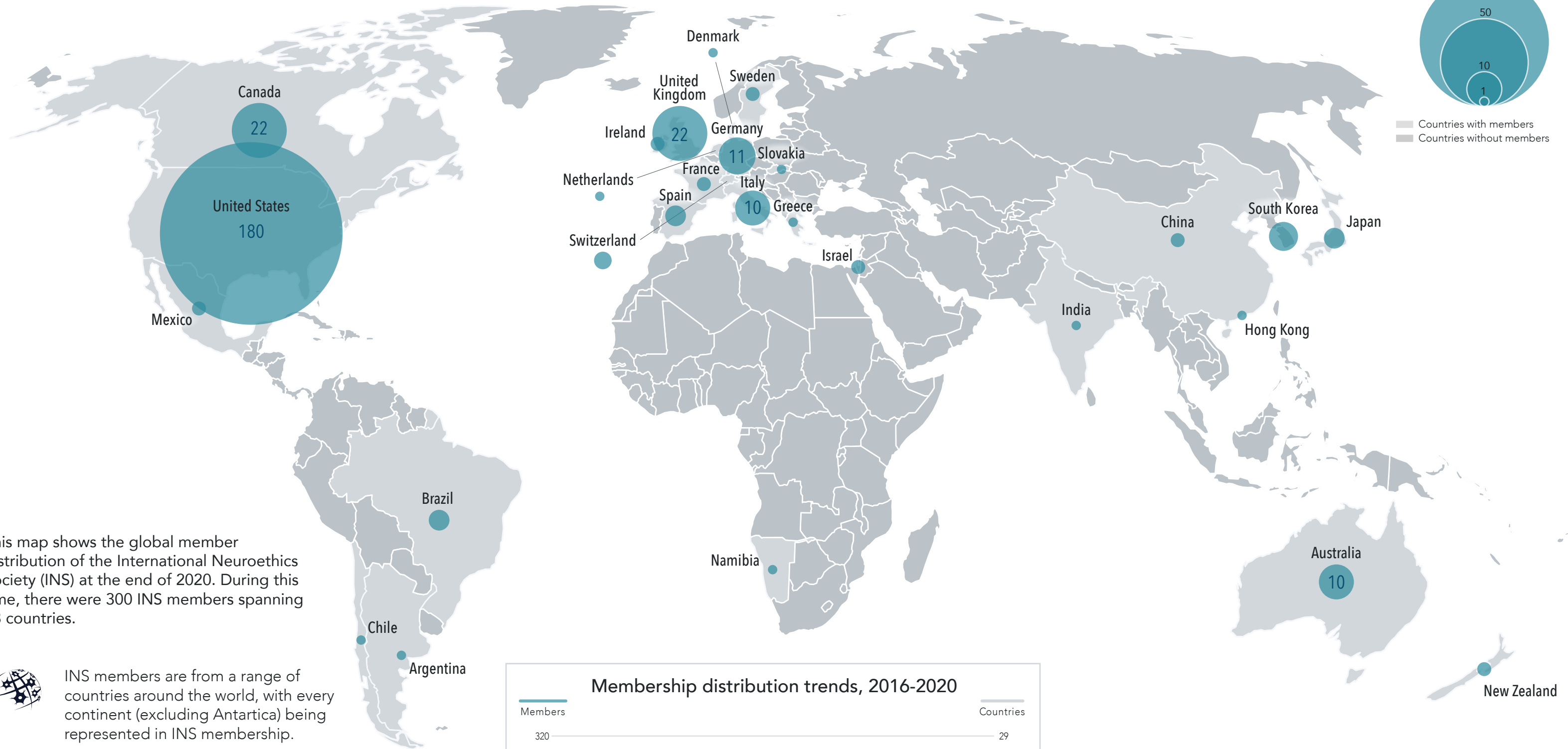


# International Neuroethics Society Membership Distribution 2020

INS members are from a range of countries around the world, with every continent (excluding Antarctica) being represented in INS membership.

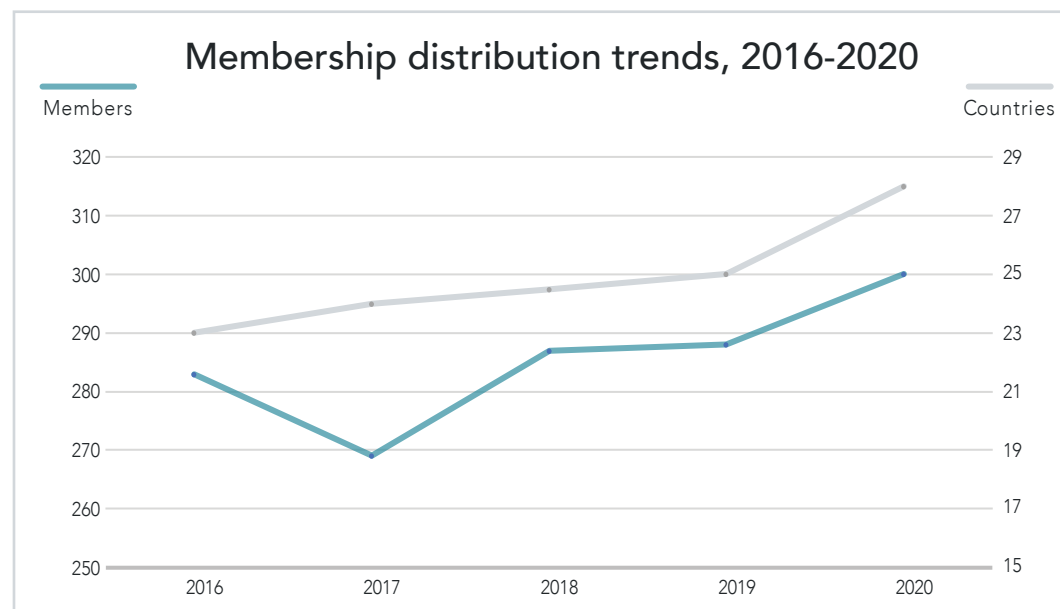


Majority of membership lies in North America and Europe.
