What is BRT anyway?

BRT or bus rapid transit is essentially high-quality bus service. It features dedicated running way in the form of bus lanes and signal priority at traffic lights. Additionally, there are significantly fewer stops and higher frequency service (approx. every 15 mins). Each station will have level boarding with real-time transit information.
