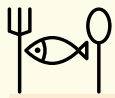


# EXPLORE THE CITY OF QINGDAO

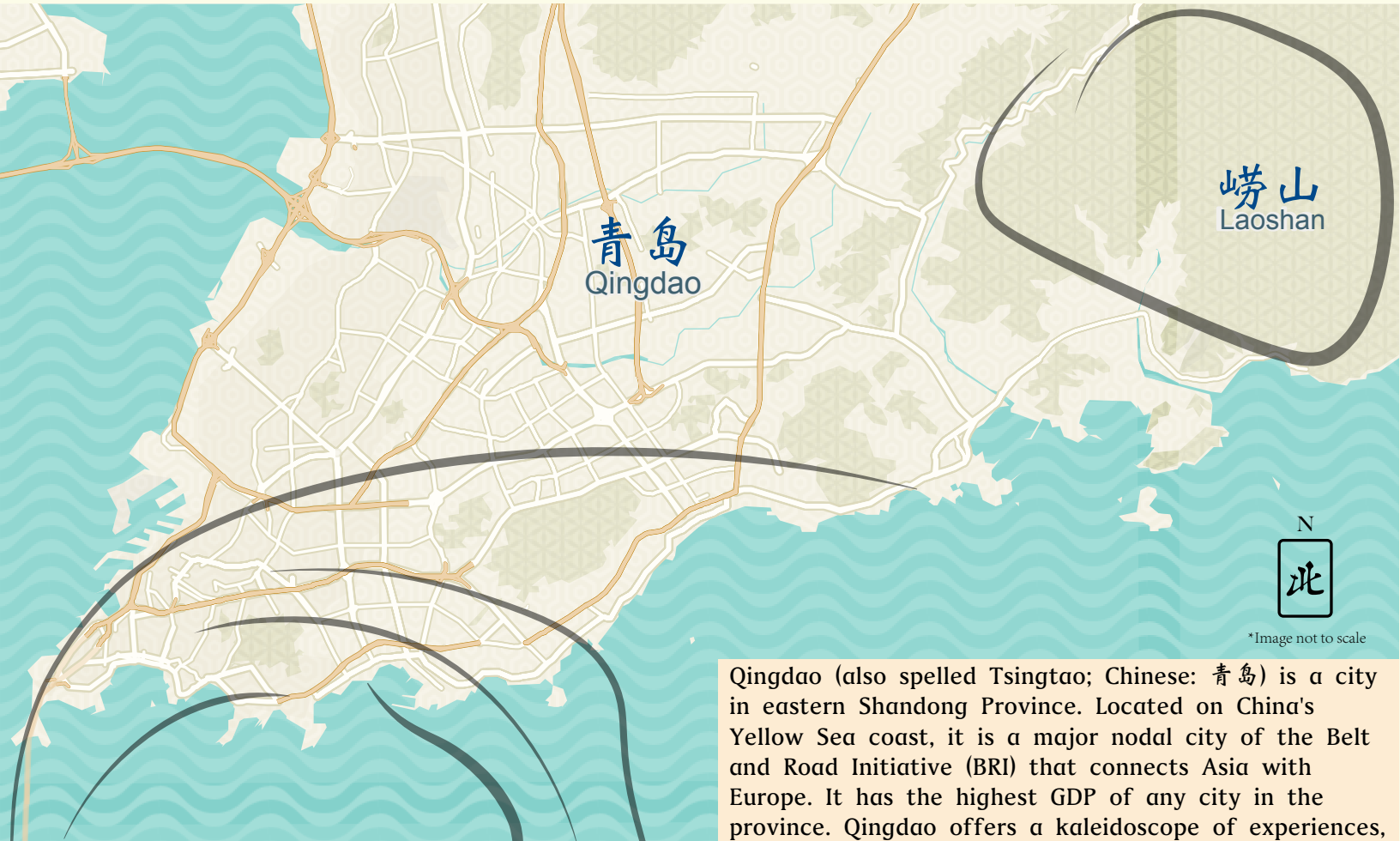
