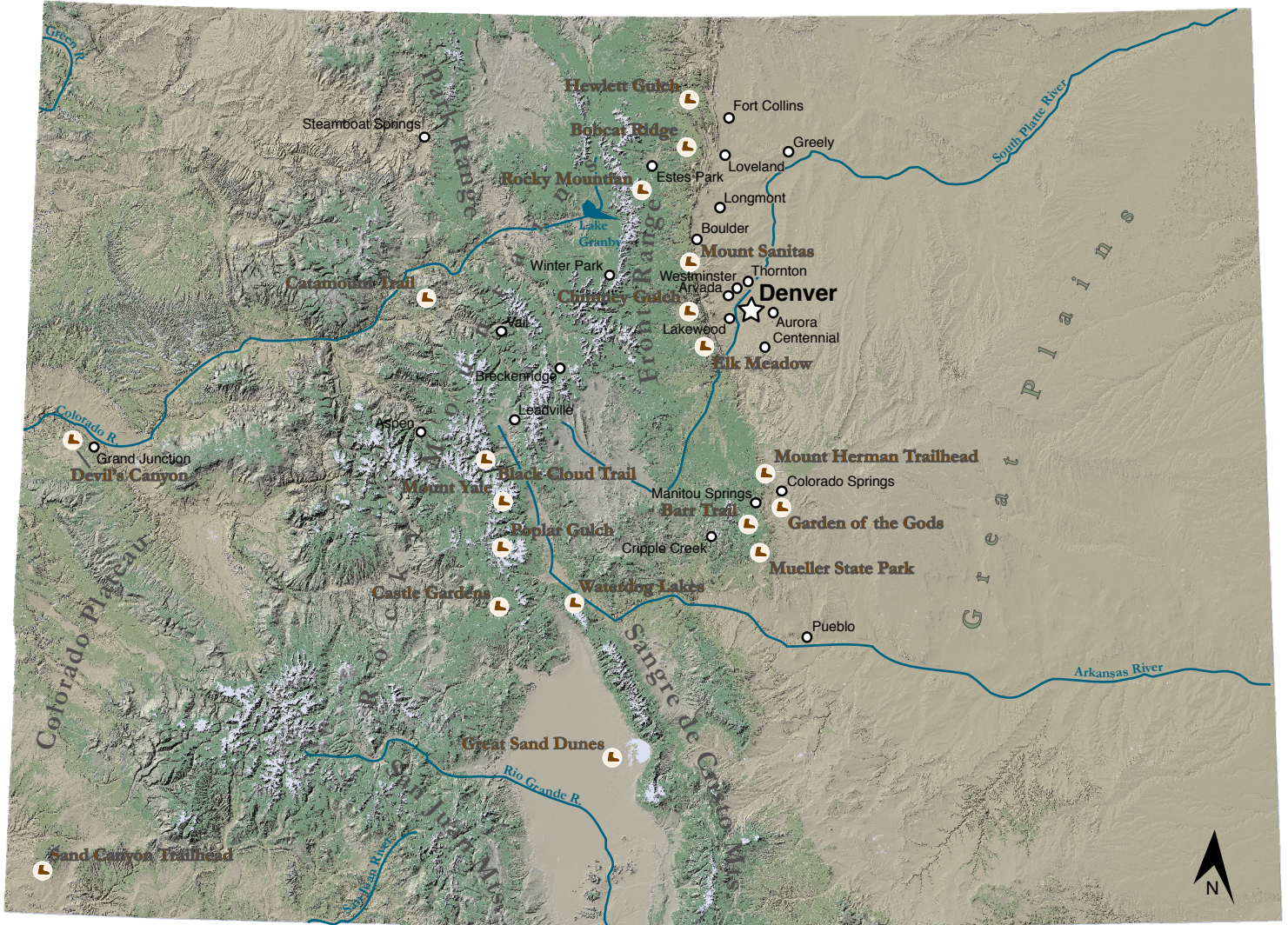





Hiking in Colorado
